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Use cases by category

The examples below are starting points, not automatic approvals. A useful AI workflow has a clear owner, approved information, a review standard and a measurable benefit.

Category	Strong first uses	Guardrail
Home improvement and trades	Scope summaries; proposal first drafts; jobsite photo organization; maintenance education; training checklists	Never infer concealed conditions or make unreviewed code, safety, structural, warranty or price commitments.
Professional services	Research outlines; meeting preparation; document comparison; client education drafts	Protect privilege and confidentiality; verify laws, calculations and professional conclusions.
Real estate and property services	Listing drafts; property-management communications; maintenance triage scripts; local research plans	Verify fair housing, advertising and disclosure requirements. Do not fabricate property facts.
Hospitality and food service	Guest-response drafts; menu descriptions; staff training; review-theme analysis	Keep food safety, allergy, wage and customer-data decisions under qualified human control.
Health, wellness and personal care	Educational-content drafts; scheduling scripts; intake organization; follow-up templates	Do not diagnose or make treatment decisions. Protect regulated and sensitive information.
Retail and e-commerce	Product-description drafts; merchandising ideas; FAQ drafts; review-theme analysis	Verify inventory, pricing, claims, endorsements and accessibility.
Automotive and transportation	Inspection-note summaries; maintenance education; service reminders; training checklists	Technicians remain responsible for diagnostics, safety and repair decisions.
Nonprofit and community organizations	Grant-research plans; volunteer communications; event planning; impact-story drafts	Protect donor and beneficiary information; verify eligibility, claims and reporting.

A repeatable category test

- Demand: Does the workflow solve a frequent customer or staff problem?
- Data: Can it be completed with information the business is permitted to use?
- Review: Can a qualified person quickly detect a bad answer?
- Consequence: If the output is wrong, can it be corrected before harm occurs?
- Measurement: Can the business compare time, quality, response rate or customer satisfaction?
